

Quitcards Provider Criteria

To be accepted as a Quitcards Provider, certain criteria have to be met. These criteria protect the integrity of the Quitcards system, and they also reduce valuable administrative time at The Quit Group.

The criteria are:

- The applicant must have a client or customer base (for example, a nurse in a medical practice has the practice's client base; a minister of religion has his congregation).
- The applicant must work from an organisation (for example, a hospital; a surgery; a church group or marae) and must note organisation details on the registration form. These details must include full postal address and postcode.
- If working on a casual basis the applicant must still use their organisation address details to receive Quitcards.
- Only midwives, independent occupational therapist or locums are able to use their home address details to receive the Quitcards.
- Before being registered as a Quitcards Provider, student nurses must either: have finished their training within the university; be employed there as a student nurse or be working as a student nurse employed in the hospital.
- The Quitcards programme is only available for New Zealand residents.
- The applicant must have a safe place to store the Quitcards.

Changing organisation/role

If you obtain further employment that allows you to issue Quitcards, then your role as a Quitcards Provider may continue if the above criteria are met. However you must contact the Quitcards Co-ordinator to update your organisation's contact details.
