

# Quitcards Provider Criteria

To be accepted as a Quitcards Provider, certain criteria have to be met. These criteria protect the integrity of the Quitcards system, and they also reduce valuable administrative time at The Quit Group.

## The criteria are:

- Quitcard applicants must fall into one of these two categories:
  1. Have completed Cessation Practitioner Training (CPT) with an approved training organisation; OR
  2. Have completed ABC Online Training, and are one of the following:
    - A registered healthcare worker as per the Health Practitioner Competency Act (HPCA) list
    - A 4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> Year Medical Student
    - An enrolled 3<sup>rd</sup> Year Nursing Student
    - A DAPAANZ Practitioner
- Applicants are required to provide an organisation address. Students may use the address of their education provider with their tutor's agreement.
- Midwives, Independent Occupational Therapists or Locums are able to use their home address. Other applicants requesting to use a home address will be considered on a case by case basis.
- Applicants must be a New Zealand resident.
- Applicants must have a secure place to store their Quitcards.

## Changing organisation/role

- If your employment conditions change your role as a Quitcards Provider may continue if the above criteria are met.
- You must contact the Quitcards Co-ordinator to update your details.
